Where Can I Apply This Course?

This course can teach you how to turn your simple Firehouse Software into a powerhouse. For instance, let's say your department does EMS billing and you want your personnel to specify whether they obtained a patient's signature or not. This class will not only teach you how to create a field for this, but how to create a report using this data to see what personnel are not getting signatures, what patients have not signed yet, and more. For another example, let's say you utilize the journal as your daily station log and you track when personnel call off for duty or report late for duty. You decide that you want to know how many times Firefighter Jones has been late to work in 2009. This class will teach you the skills necessary to create this report.

Many of us do not utilize this software to its full potential and this course will help you along the way.

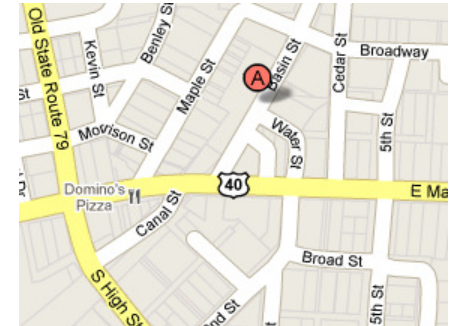
Registration: Registration for the course must be made on our website above.
